## **Edward Alan Lindgren**

Edward Lindgren was the owner of Below Zero Studios and a promoter of arts and entertainment in Orlando. Founded Below Zero nightclub at the Lamar Hotel in 1986 where he featured progressive music. After opening Below Zero Studios in the Acme Glass Building on West Colonial Drive in 1989, he started a weekly, Monday night gathering at which artists bring one work to exhibit. One of the gallery's exhibits, "Orlando: Dusk to Dawn" met with controversy when it became the first in Orlando's new City Hall. Two of the photos were removed from the exhibit when an aide to Mayor Bill Frederick found them offensive. They later were returned. Lindgren was a member of Central Floridians Against Censorship Inc., and associate member of the Orlando Museum of Art and a member of the Downtown Entertainment Task Force.
