# Mammogram Offered To Employees At Reduced Rate

Colonial Williamsburg, in conjunction with Williamsburg Community Hospital and the Wellness Works Wonders Fitness Program, is offering mammogram x-rays at the reduced rate of \$50. Mammograms normally cost \$82 and are not covered by Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Virginia health

Women between the ages 35 and 40 should have at least one base-line mammogram. Women between the ages of 40 and 50 should have a mammogram once every two years. Women over age 50 should have a mammogram every year.

One in ten women born today will develop breast cancer. This year 130,000 American women will develop breast cancer and based on current statistics, more than half of them will die from it. Breast cancer is the most common cancer affecting American women.

Finding this cancer earlier increases not only a woman's chance of survival, but also her treatment options. Breast cancer can be seen on a mammogram much earlier than it can be felt in an examination.

The whole procedure only takes about thirty minutes; include your travel to and from the hospital, and the time away from your job is equal to that of a lunch hour. Talk to your supervisor; take advantage of this opportunity to safeguard your health.

Appointments are available between 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Tuesday, March 22; Thursday, March 24; Monday, March 28; and Friday, April 1; and between 2:30 and 4 p.m. on Wednesday, March 30.

### 1988 Compensation Guidelines Announced

Although the Federal minimum wage remains \$3.35, the Foundation has increased the entire rate/range structure for non-bargaining unit jobs by 3%. This means that both ends of salary ranges-beginnings and tops--have gone up.

Salaries of employees earning less than the 1988 beginnings of grades were increased to those rates starting January 3. On individual merit review dates these employees will receive the full amount of recommended merit increase.

Merit increase guidelines for nonbargaining unit employees are:

Outstanding: 6-5% Very Good: 4-3% Good: 2% Fair/Unsatisfactory: 0%

With administrative officer approval those employees performing exceptionally may receive increases beyond the 6% limit.

Promotional increases continue to range from 2% to 12% with increases of 6% or more establishing new merit review dates.
