Colonial Williamsburg, in conjunction with Williamsburg Community Hospital and the Wellness Works Wonders program, is offering mammogram x-rays at the reduced rate of \$50. Mammograms normally cost \$82 and are not covered by Blue Cross/Blue Shield health care insurance.

Appointments are available between 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Tuesday, March 22; on Thursday, March 24; on Monday, March 28; and on Friday, April 1. They are also available between 2:30 p.m. and 4 p.m. on Wednesday, March 30.
