The directory includes those individuals who appeared to have been a Williamsburg resident at some time during the year 1775 and were independent householders. The list does not include known apprentices or indentured servants, or older teenage children unless they appear to be acting as independent adults. College students are also not listed nor are members of the military that were garrisoned in and around Williamsburg in the summer and fall of 1775. Common abbreviations are: FDM [First Date Mentioned/Known in Williamsburg]; LDM [Last Dated Mentioned/Known in Williamsburg]; FAA [Free African Americans].
