The University of Baltimore opens with 62 law students and 114 business administration students. Wilber F. Smith becomes its first president.

The first classes of business and law school students graduate. This same year, tennis, fencing and basketball are established as the first UB sports teams.

Howell A. King becomes UB's second president. Five years later, in 1938, UB is selected by the Civil Aeronautics Administration to offer civilian pilot training.

Theodore H. Wilson serves as the University's third president from 1940-61. In 1952, the 45-acre Mount Washington campus opens.

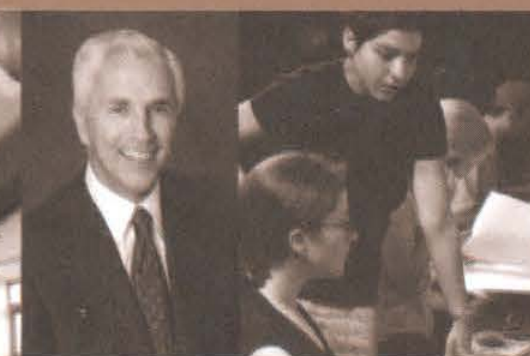
UB becomes a part of the University System of Maryland.

**THE STORY BEHIND
THE UNIVERSITY SEAL**

Baltimore is filled with monuments; one of them is the Battle Monument, which is depicted on the University's seal. It was erected to commemorate the Battle of North Point and the Bombardment of Fort McHenry during the War of 1812. The Battle of North Point inspired Francis Scott Key to compose "The Star-Spangled Banner." The monument recalls the battle and serves as a memorial to the men who defended Baltimore. The University of Baltimore is proud to depict the monument on its seal because of UB's commitment to the city and its communities.

PROMINENCE OF THE MACE

The mace, carried by the senior marshal to lead the ceremonial procession, is a symbol of authority. The University of Baltimore mace is 42 inches long and crafted of silver and wood, and it bears the seal of the University.
