

Articles of Agreement made & entered into this 19 day of January
1871, between Isaac E. Whitson party of the first part
and Wash King party of the second part as follows

First The said party of the first part rents and
leases to the said party of the second part ~~acres~~
of land more or less on the Lake Lafayette Plantation
from date hereof until until January 1st 1872.

Second The said party of the second part for and in
consideration of the rent of said land agrees to
pay to the said party of the first part one fourth part
of all the crops raised by him on said piece or parcel
of land, said ~~rent~~ fourth to be paid and delivered
on or before the first day of January next, and the
said party of the ~~second~~ part does hereby make and
make in favor of the said party of the first part
a full preferred and prior mortgage lien on and
the crops raised and grown by him on said land
and on all ~~other~~ ~~and~~ other property placed
or used by him on said piece of land to secure
to him the said party of the first part the rent
due to her for said land, as aforesaid, and
to secure the payment to her the said party of the
first part of all debts due or which may become
due by him the said party of the ~~second~~ part to
her the said party of the first part.

Articles of Agreement made and entered into this day
of 1871 between Susan E. Winthrop party of the
first part, and the undersigned hands parties of the
second part as follows

First = The said hands agree to work for the said Susan E.
Winthrop from date hereof until the first day of January
1872 on her Barrow Plantation in Leon County Florida
+ in the performance of the agreement to work from sun-
=rise until sunset + in all things to be subject to the
order + directions of the said Susan E. Winthrop or her
assigns.

Second = The said Susan E. Winthrop for and in consider-
=ation of the time + faithful performance on the part and behalf
of the hands of all the covenants by them entered into as
in ^{and} ~~in~~ ~~the~~ ~~said~~ ~~articles~~ ~~of~~ ~~the~~ ~~said~~ ~~articles~~
of all the Cotton raised, raised, guinea and paper
for market by them on said plantation during the time
aforesaid; and one third of all the sugar & other raised
by them, and one half of all the other products raised by
them on said plantation during the time aforesaid
the said hands to feed and support them selves, or
to be furnished in their own course by the said Susan
E. Winthrop if she so elect, and they so decide,

to exceed four pounds of wheat or one
peck of meal per week on an average, and payment for such
provisions furnished, and all debts, including pay for extra
labor employed, which the said hands may incur to the
said Susan E. Winthrop, to be made from the share of
crop coming to each hand so indebted, and the said
parties of the second part do hereby make and create in favor
of the said party of the first part a first preferred and prior
mortgage lien on each and all of the shares, and on



all other products belonging to them for the payment of all debts due or which may become due by them to the said party of the first part.

Third: It is hereby agreed by both parties to this Contract that it shall be the reserved privilege of the said party of the first part or her assign, to discharge at any time from her or simply any hand who may violate this Contract at the discretion of the said Susan E. Orin the party of the first part or her assign, and in case of such discharge the said party of the first part shall pay and the said hand shall receive payment at the end of the quarter in which he or she is discharged at the rate of Five Dollars per month after deducting therefrom for all indebtedness due by said hand to said party of the first part, and for all time lost by said hand which loss time it is hereby agreed shall be paid for at the rate of thirty five cents per day for all time lost.

Fourth: It is hereby agreed by both parties to this Contract that there shall be for holidays one day in each month to be selected at the option of the said party of the first part or her assign.
