WENT UP IN A BALLOON.

Two Men Make an Ascension at Bloomington.

Bloomington, Ill., July 19.-Thomas Baldwin, the aeronaut of Quincy, and Lee Cheney of Bloomington made an ascension from the courthouse square in this city at 6:40 yesterday evening with Baldwin's great balloon, Mars, intending to make a journey to Chicago. The ascension was witnessed by about 2,000 persons. The balloon was not fully inflated when released, but sailed away to the northeast. Later it took a nearly eastern course. An hour after its departure it was visible with opera glasses and seemed to be gradually rising. It returned to earth in a pa-ture five and one-half miles from Colfax, this county, twenty-five miles from Bloomington, having been in the air a little longer than one hour.
