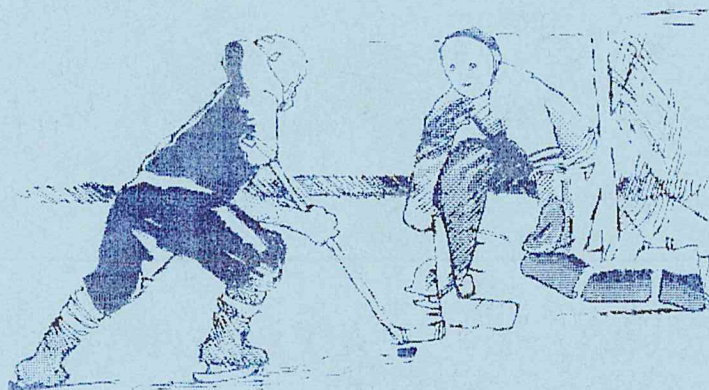

## **LOGAN COLLEGE OF CHIROPRACTIC**

Logan College of Chiropractic enrolled its first class September 1, 1935. Founded by Dr. Hugh B. Logan, the college was to provide the profession with a self-supporting, nonprofit institution offering a four year chiropractic educational program. Today, this academic program has been developed into five academic years with a minimum prerequisite of two years in an accredited college or university.

The 103 acre park-like campus contains well equipped, newly renovated classrooms, a computerized learning resources center, a spacious health center where student interns treat outpatients, and administrative offices. An adjacent 33,000 square foot building houses the Science, Research and Ergonomics Center. In addition to the on-going campus health center, Logan College also operates satellite clinics in the metro St. Louis area providing student interns with a wealth of diagnostic and treatment experiences.

More than 50 years after its inception, Logan College of Chiropractic continues to offer excellence in chiropractic education and to produce graduates known for their clinical skills.

Logan College initially received specialized accreditation by the Council on Chiropractic Education in 1978 and most recently received renewal in 1991. Logan is also accredited by the Commission on Institutions of Higher Education of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

Logan College is located at 1851 Schoettler Road, P.O. Box 1065, Chesterfield, Missouri 63006-1065.

## **LOGAN COLLEGE HOCKEY CLUB**

The Logan College Hockey Club enters its third season with the largest contingent of players in its history. Twenty-two players are poised for an exciting season of hockey. This season the club has its first non-student coaches, Director of Administrative Affairs, Gary Gross, and Barry Hentz, the Head of College Security.

The Logan College Hockey Club is a member of the Central States Collegiate Hockey League (CSCHL). The league is divided into north and south divisions. The southern division includes Kansas State University, Kansas University, St. Louis Community College/Meramec, University of Missouri-St. Louis, Washington University and Logan College. The northern division includes Carleton College, Dordt College, Drake University, Iowa State University, South Dakota State University and the University of Northern Iowa.

The club practices at the South County Recreation Center Ice Rink, and plays its home games at the Brentwood Ice Arena. Game times and the complete schedule is included in this program.

Funding for the Hockey Club comes from player fees, donations, the Student Doctors Council, the advertising included in this program, solicited by the players, and from the athletic department of the College.

# OFFICIAL SIGNALS

## Boarding

Striking the closed fist of the hand once into the open palm of the other hand.



**Holding** Clasp the wrist of the whistle hand well in front of the chest.



## Butt-Ending

Moving the forearm, fist closed, under the forearm of the other hand held palm down.



## Delayed (Slow) Whistle

(Blue-Line Off-Sides) The non-whistle hand is extended straight above head. If play returns to Neutral Zone without stoppage, the arm is drawn down the instant the puck crosses the line, or as soon as the offending team clears the zone.



## Holding the Face Mask

Closed fist held in front of face, palm in, and pulled down in one straight motion.



## Hooking

A tugging motion with both arms, as if pulling something toward the stomach.



## Charging

Rotating clenched fists around one another in front of chest.

## Checking from Behind

Arm placed behind the back, elbow bent, forearm parallel to the ice surface.



## Icing

Arms folded across the chest. When the puck is shot or deflected in such a manner as to produce a possible icing of the puck, the back Linesman will signal to his partner by raising his "non-whistle" hand over his head (same as in Slow Whistle). The instant that the conditions required to establish "icing the puck" have occurred, the front Linesman will blow his whistle to stop the play. The back Linesman will give the "icing" signal.



## Spearing

A single jabbing motion with both hands together, thrust forward from in front of the chest then dropping hands to the side.



## Hand Pass

The non-whistle hand (open hand) and arm are placed straight down alongside the body and swung forward and up once in an underhand motion.



## Cross-Checking

A forward motion with both fists clenched extending from the chest.



## Tripping

Strike the side of the knee and follow through once, keeping the head up and both skates on the ice.

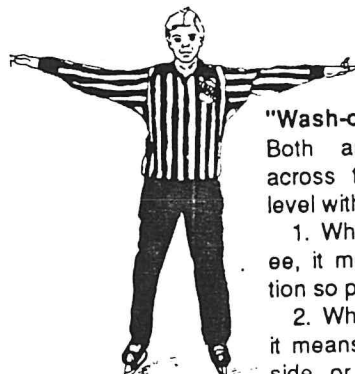


## "Wash-out"

Both arms swung laterally across the body at shoulder level with palms down.

1. When used by the Referee, it means no goal or violation so play shall continue.

2. When used by Linesmen, it means there is no icing, off-side, or high sticking violation.





**Delayed Calling of Penalty**  
The non-whistle hand is extended straight above the head.

**Interference**  
Crossed arms stationary in front of chest with fists closed.



**Elbowing**  
Tapping the elbow with the opposite hand.



**Misconduct**  
Placing of both hands on hips one time.



**Kneeling**  
A single tap of the right knee with the right hand, keeping both skates on the ice.



**Delaying the Game**  
The non-whistle hand, palm open, is placed across the chest and then fully extended directly in front of the body.



**Fighting (Roughing)**  
One punching motion to the side with the arm extending from the shoulder.



**High-Sticking**  
Holding both fists, clenched, one immediately above the other, at the side of the head.

**Unsportsmanlike Conduct**  
Using both hands to form a "T".



**Slashing**  
One chop of the hand across the straightened forearm of the other hand



**Penalty Shot**  
Arms crossed (fists clenched) above head.



**Goal Scored**  
A single point, with the non-whistle hand, directly at the goal in which the puck legally entered, while simultaneously blowing the whistle.



**Match Penalty**  
Pat flat of hand on the top of the head.
