LOGAN COLLEGE OF CHIROPRACTIC

Logan College of Chiropractic enrolled its first class September 1, 1935. Founded by Dr. Hugh B. Logan, the college was to provide the profession with a self-supporting, nonprofit institution offering a four year chiropractic educational program. Today, this academic program has been developed into five academic years with a minimum prerequisite of two years in an accredited college or university.

The 103 acre park-like campus contains well equipped, newly renovated classrooms, a computerized learning resources center, a spacious health center where student interns threat outpatients, and administrative offices. An adjacent 33,000 square foot building houses the Science, Research and Ergonomics Center. In addition to the on-going campus health center, Logan College also operates satellite clinics in the metro St. Louis area providing student interns with a wealth of diagnostic and treatment experiences.

More than 50 years after its inception, Logan College of Chiropractic continues to offer excellence in chiropractic education and to produce graduates known for their clinical skills.

Logan College initially received specialized accreditation by the Council on Chiropractic Education in 1978 and most recently received renewal in 1991. Logan is also accredited by the Commission on Institutions of Higher Education of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

Logan College is located at 1851 Schoettler Road, P.O. Box 1065, Chesterfield, Missouri 63006-1065.

Funding for the Hockey Club comes from player fees, donations, the Student Doctors Council, the advertising included in this program, solicited by the players, and from the athletic department of the College.

OFFICIAL SIGNALS



Boarding

Striking the closed fist of the hand once into the open palm of the other hand.



Holding the Face Mask

Closed fist held in front of face, palm in, and pulled down in one straight motion.



Butt-Ending

Moving the forearm, fist closed, under the forearm of the other hand held palm down.



Holding Clasping the wrist of the whistle hand well in front of the chest.



Hooking

A tugging motion with both arms, as if pulling something toward the stomach.


Checking from Behind Arm placed behind the back, elbow bent, forearm parallel to

the ice surface.

Charging Rotating clenched fists around one another in front of chest.



Arms folded across the chest. When the puck is shot or deflected in such a manner as to produce a possible icing of the puck, the back Linesman will signal to his partner by raising his "nonwhistle" hand over his head (same as in Slow Whistle). The instant that the conditions required to establish "icing the puck" have occurred, the front Linesman will blow his whistle to stop the play. The back Linesman will give the



"icing" signal



zone.

Spearing

A single jabbing motion with both hands together, thrust for ward from in front of the chest then dropping hands to the side.



Hand Pass

The non-whistle hand (open hand) and arm are placed straight down alongside the body and swung forward and up once in an underhand motion.



Tripping

Strike the side of the knee and follow through once, keeping the head up and both skates on the ice



Cross-Checking

A forward motion with both fists clenched extending from the chest.



'Wash-out"

Both arms swung laterally across the body at shoulder level with palms down.

- 1. When used by the Referee, it means no goal or violation so play shall continue.
- 2. When used by Linesmen, it means there is no icing, offside, or high sticking violation.

Placing of both hands on hips

Interference

Crossed arms stationary in front of chest with fists closed.



Elbowing

Tapping the elbow with the opposite hand.



Delayed Calling of Penalty

The non-whistle hand is extended straight above the head.



Kneeing

A single tap of the right knee with the right hand, keeping both skates on the ice.



Delaying the Game

The non-whistle hand, palm open, is placed across the chest and then fully extended directly in front of the body.



Fighting (Roughing)

One punching motion to the side with the arm extending from the shoulder.




Unsportsmanlike Conduct Using both hands to form a "T".

High-Sticking

Holding both fists, clenched, one immediately above the other, at the side of the head.



One chop of the hand across the straightened forearm of the



Penalty Shot

Arms crossed (fists clenched) above head.



Goal Scored

A single point, with the nonwhistle hand, directly at the goal in which the puck legally entered, while simultaneously blowing the whistle.



Match Penalty

Pat flat of hand on the top of the head.
