It was a decade that brought dramatic social and political change, **flare and freedom to women**, and advances in science and technology.

The Roaring Twenties was a decade of economic growth and prosperity driven by recovery from wartime devastation, **decreased spending, a construction boom and the rapid growth of consumer goods** such as automobiles and electricity in North America and Europe.

The Wall Street crash ended the era in 1929 as the Great Depression brought years of hardship.

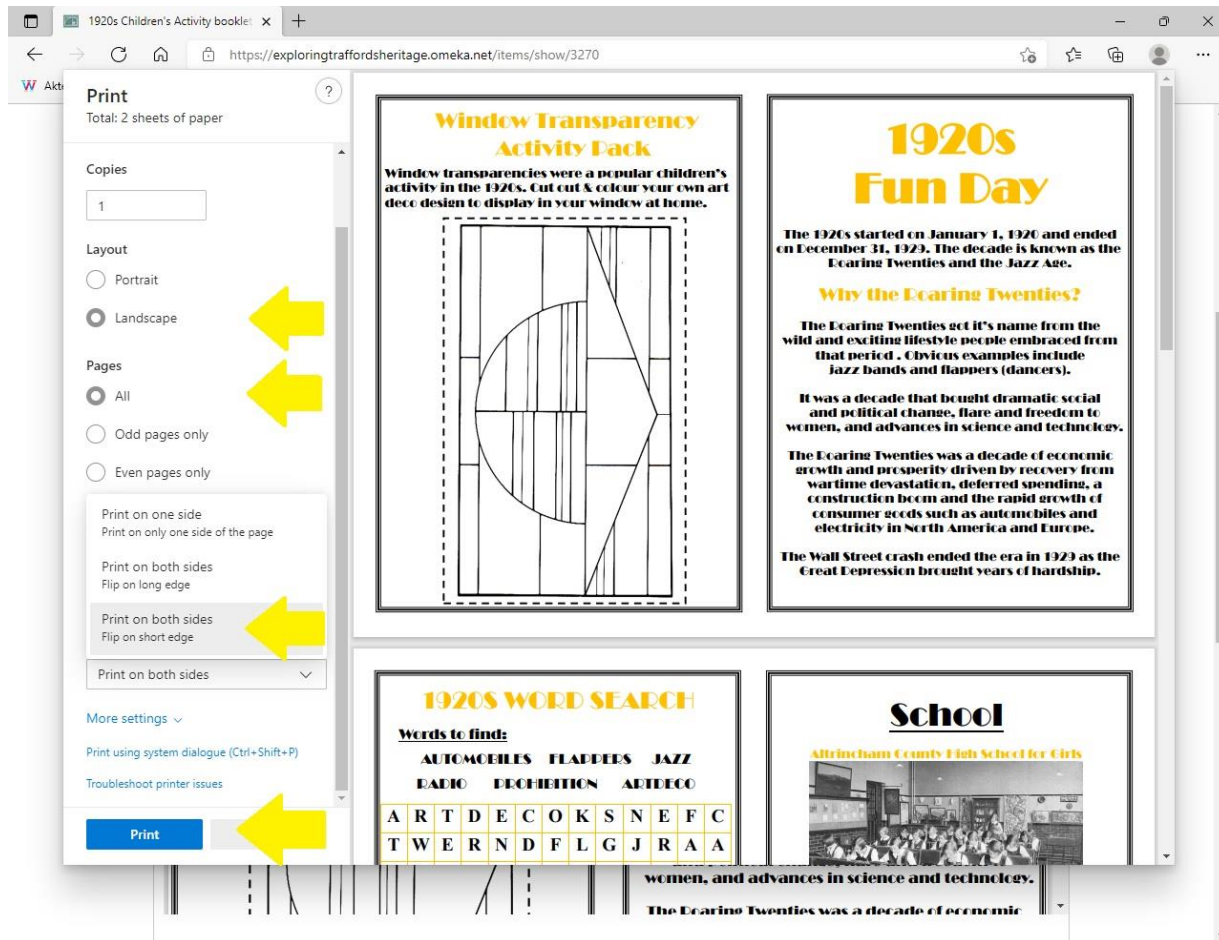
