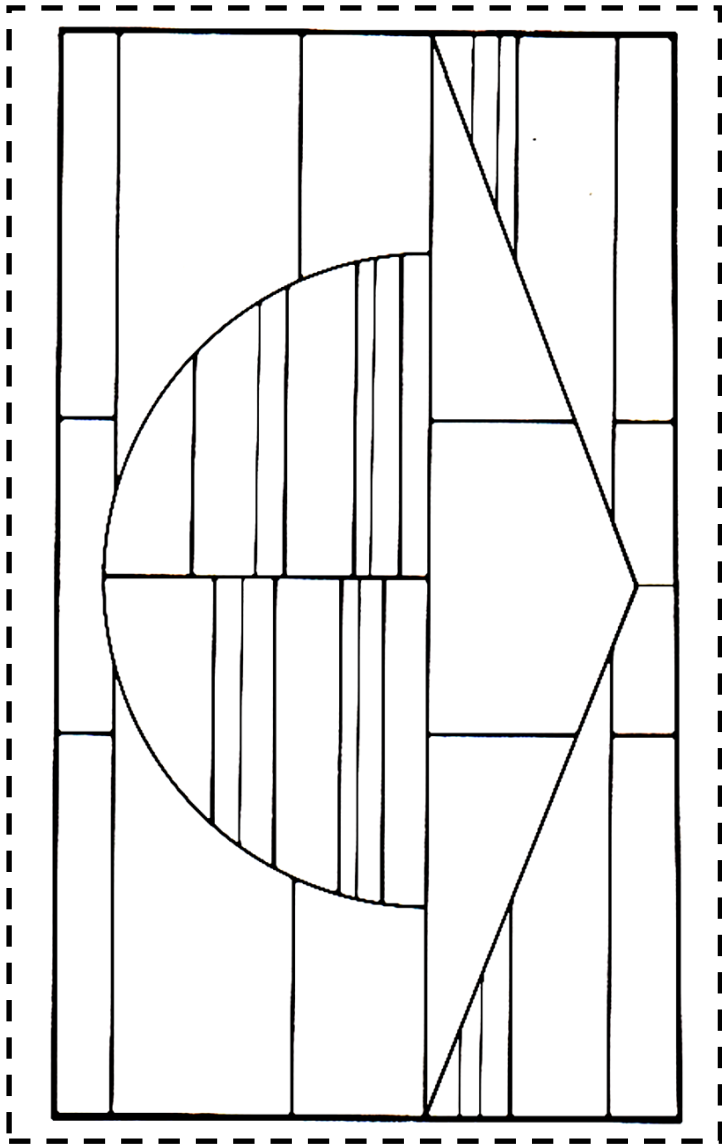


Window Transparency Activity Pack

1920s Fun Day

The 1920s started on January 1, 1920 and ended on December 31, 1929. The decade is known as the Roaring Twenties and the Jazz Age.

Why the Roaring Twenties?

The Roaring Twenties got its name from the wild and exciting lifestyle people embraced from that period. Obvious examples include jazz bands and flappers (dancers).

It was a decade that brought dramatic social and political change, flare and freedom to women, and advances in science and technology.

The Roaring Twenties was a decade of economic growth and prosperity driven by recovery from wartime devastation, deferred spending, a construction boom and the rapid growth of consumer goods such as automobiles and electricity in North America and Europe.

The Wall Street crash ended the era in 1929 as the Great Depression brought years of hardship.
