### Eileen Foley Newspaper Columns Scope and Contents Note

Eileen Foley, retired associate editor of *The Blade*, donated this collection of newspaper columns and readers' responses to Local History & Genealogy Department. The columns were published between 1998 and 2004. Ms. Foley wrote about a wide range of subjects from evolution to gun control to the Catholic Church.

The column that provoked the greatest response, most of which was negative, was published on September 14, 2001 and discussed President Bush's reactions the first days after September 11. The response by email and regular mail was heavy. The majority of the responders identified themselves with by far the greatest volume of response by email. Ms. Foley did respond to most of the emails she received. Occasionally, her response then developed into a discussion that continued back and forth for several messages.
