# Sandy Isenberg Papers Biographical Sketch & Contents Note

Sandra Welch Isenberg was born in Toledo, Ohio to Harry and Ann Welch. She graduated DeVilbiss High School in 1957. She left college to marry Marshall Isenberg after attending Ohio State University and Toledo University. They had two sons, Michael and Dennis.

Sandy became active in politics after working on a friend's campaign in the late 1960s. She served as a precinct committee person before becoming the first female Lucas County Democratic Party Ward Chairman. She was a Deputy Recorder in the Lucas County Recorders Office from 1971 to 1977, then a member of Toledo City Council from 1977 to 1979 when she was appointed County Recorder. She was elected Recorder in 1980 and served until 1985 when she was appointed County Commissioner. She was first elected commissioner in 1986. She became President of the Commissioners in 1992 and served in that role until December 2002 after losing re-election in November. She was the first woman to hold the positions of County Recorder, County Commissioner and President of the County Commissioners in Lucas County.

She was recognized by the YWCA and the Management Forum of Northwest Ohio in 1996 as a recipient of the "Milestones: A Tribute to Women" award. She has been the recipient of numerous awards and honors and has been actively involved in many community organizations as well as the Democratic Party. She was a co-founder of the Democratic Business and Professional Women of Lucas County and a founder of Women Involved in Toledo.

The collection consists primarily of records from political campaigns, as well as numerous awards, honors and photographs.
