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# Librarians are already DHists...



DH is...“an umbrella term for a number of different activities that surround technology and humanities scholarship...includ[ing] topics like **open access to materials, intellectual property rights, ...digital libraries**, data mining, born-digital **preservation**, ...study of **the impact of technology** on numerous fields... **technology for teaching and learning**...and many others” (Gavin, Smith & Bobley 2012).

- These issues are **discussed in-depth** at local, regional, national and international LIS conferences.
- Such activities are **easily mapped to the ALA Core Competencies for Librarians**.

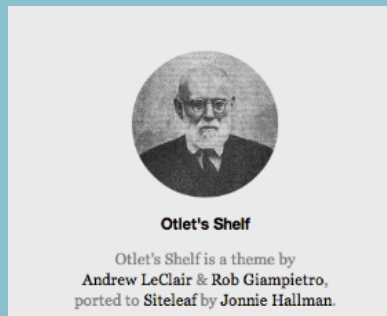


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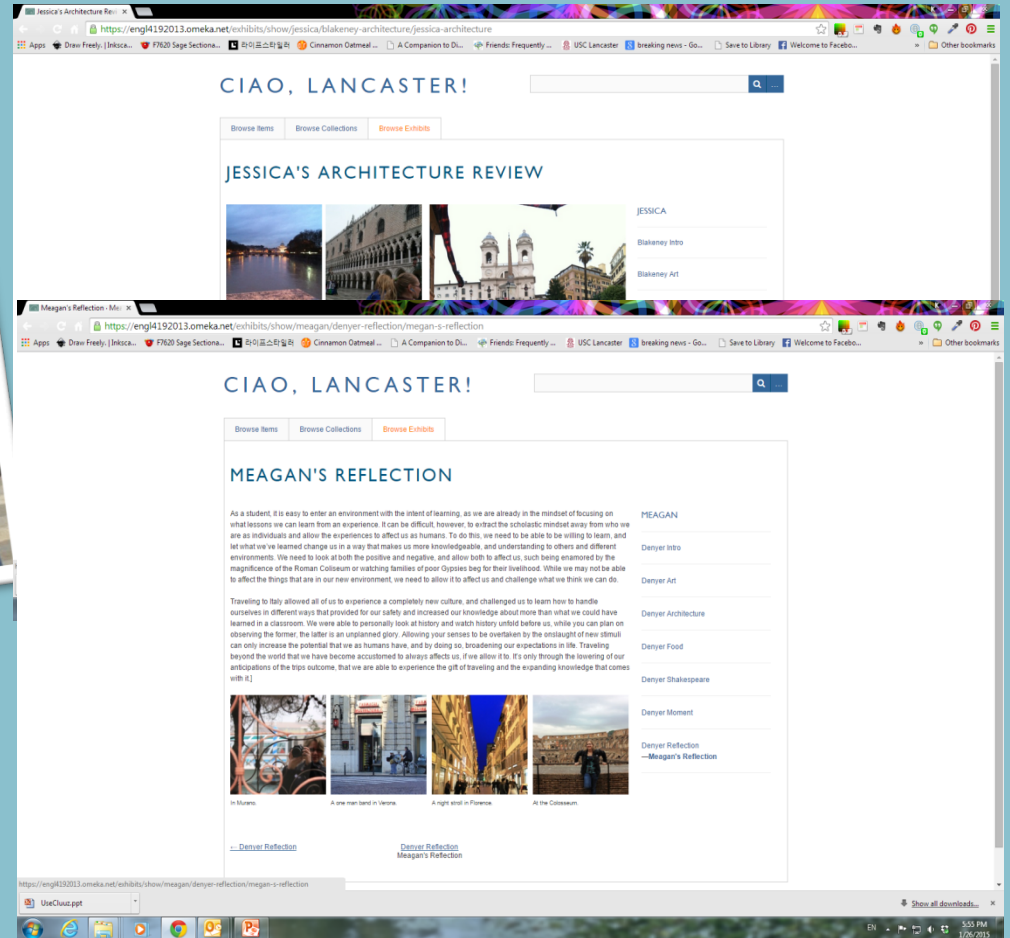
