The Tessellation Project began in March 2020 as a request to our creative community to join us to make communal artistic expressions during this time of physical seclusion and social disruption. The goal of this project is to curate individual artistic pieces from a variety of mediums into communal works of art.

The next phase of the Tessellation Project is *Ritual*.



We create rituals to focus our minds on a task that brings solemnness and intention to our day-to-day lives. When the space we inhabit and our connection with others is restricted, tested, or adjusted, a ritual becomes a touchpoint, a reassurance, a way to connect to ourselves in a way that can create meaning. We introduce these rituals to remember, refresh, and to begin.

In an effort to reflect the recent urgent and complicated movements unfolding amongst us, we want to add the idea of movement to the medium we choose for this phase.

We invite you to submit an artistic vision of your ritual in the form of either a 15-second video, animated gif, or still image. The submission
