Our Shakespeare Community,

We hope you and your family have been well during this trying time. We value and thank you for the generous support you provide that makes it possible for us to serve thousands across Nebraska.

Having discussed the COVID-19 pandemic with members of our Board of Directors and staff, we don't see a way where we can serve our mission and put on the sort of *Shakespeare on The Green* (SOTG) production we think the community deserves. Even if the public health situation fundamentally changes soon, the lead time for producing these shows—securing actors, building sets, rehearsing, permits, et al-- means we have to make a decision about this year's SOTG now, when the future is particularly uncertain.

Accordingly, we have made the difficult decision to postpone our 2020 *SOTG* productions of *A Midsummer Night's Dream* and *Shakespeare In Love*. We will produce both shows in Summer 2021 when we will celebrate the 35th season of admission-free *Shakespeare On The Green*.

So what will we do instead? Our mission "to make Shakespeare a part of our society beyond the literature and drama classrooms" means we will forego live performance for the next few months. Instead, our near-term focus is to expand our educational programming online so that all Nebraskans can experience Shakespeare. Our Camp Shakespeare will move forward as planned and potentially move to an online experience. The *Shakespeare On Tour* production—which puts on performances in towns across the state and region—is looking at ways to significantly add performances this fall, when the situation may be very different In this way we hope to maximize our impact under the unprecedented circumstances.
