## **Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium Reopens June 1**

Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium plans to open its outdoor exhibits on Monday, June 1, 2020, after being closed to the public since March 16 due to the coronavirus crisis.

We can't wait to see you! To adhere to health and safety guidelines, the Zoo has made some changes to ensure a "healthy you, healthy Zoo." At this time of opening, the Zoo will offer an outdoor walk-through experience only. All guests - members and non-members - must make a ticket reservation before visiting.

The opening of the Zoo is planned as a one-way "walking safari," including social distancing, and enhanced cleaning and disinfecting protocols based on health and safety guidelines provided by state and local authorities. Guests are strongly encouraged to wear face masks while on Zoo property.

"We are excited to reopen and welcome everyone back to the Zoo," said Dennis Pate, director and CEO of Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium. "We are so grateful for the outpouring of community support during our closure." Dennis Pate continued, "The Zoo's reopening plan has been done with deliberate thought and discussion to keep the safety of our guests, animals, and employees as our utmost priority. Our plan is very

conservative, but we believe that by taking one careful step at a time, we can assure a safe and enjoyable Zoo experience for all."


## **Scout Programs**

**More experiences.** Explore different parts of the world as often as you like.


**More science.** You'll help defend species around the planet, as well as increase their numbers through breeding programs. Every birth and hatch represents hope.

Wildlife Safari Park in Ashland, Nebraska is **open for the season,** with the daily hours of **9 a.m. to 5 p.m.** 

Due to the current COVID-19 crisis, the Wildlife Safari Park will be limited to a **drive-through only experience at this time.** Several areas will not be accessible by guests on foot including the hiking trails, Visitor Center, the Hands-On Corral, Eagle Aviary, and the Bison Overlook and Nature Play Area.

As a thank you to Zoo members for their continued support through the coronavirus crisis, active Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo and Aquarium memberships will be honored for admittance to the Wildlife Safari Park through Sunday, May 31, 2020.

Beginning Monday, June 1, 2020 you must <u>add-on</u> the Wildlife Safari Park to your Zoo membership or regular admission rates apply.

To thank the community for their support as well, and to adjust for limiting Wildlife Safari Park access to only driving through, prices are being lowered for non-members during this time.

## Pricing during this time is as follows:

- \$6.00 Adults (12 and over)
- \$4.00 Children (3-11)

- \$5.00 Seniors (65 and over)
- FREE Children 2 and under
- FREE for active Omaha's Zoo and Aquarium members through Sunday, May 31, 2020.

Military personnel receive \$1 off in all categories.

## Helpful tips!

- Arrive earlier in the day to beat the crowd on expected busy days, like weekends.
   Monday-Thursday are less busy days.
- Please bring your patience if you visit on a busier day as it will take a little longer to travel through the Park.
- Snacks are now available for purchase.
- Restrooms are available, but please limit to 10 people at a time and keep a six-foot distance between yourself and others.

**Travel Notice:** Bridgework to begin on I-80 east of the Mahoney interchange. Weather permitting, work will begin April 6, east and westbound at the Mahoney interchange on I-80, according to the Nebraska Department of Transportation. Traffic on I-80 will be reduced to two lanes both directions. Motorists are urged to drive cautiously through construction zones and to look for alternate routes. Click here to learn more.
