

His Indenture

Witnesseth That *Sarah Smith* by and with the Consent of us the Subscribers two of the Justices of the Peace in & for the County of Philadelphia & by & with the Consent of *John Smith & Samuel Levis* owners of the Lot of the township of Roxborough in the County aforesaid - HATH put herself, and by these Presents,

DOTH voluntarily, and of her own free Will and Accord, put herself Apprentice to *Daniel Smith* of Roxborough township aforesaid -

to learn ~~h~~ Art, Trade, and Mystery, and after the Manner of an Apprentice to serve *the said Daniel Smith and his Heirs* from the Day of the Date hereof, for and during, and to the full End and Term of *Seventeen years and three Months* next ensuing. During all which Term, the said Apprentice her said Master faithfully shall serve, h~~is~~ Secrets keep, h~~is~~ lawful Commands every where readily obey. She shall do no Damage to her said Master - nor see it to be done by others, without letting or giving Notice thereof to her said Master - She shall not waste her said Masters - Goods, nor lend them unlawfully to any. She shall not commit Fornication, nor contract Matrimony within the said Term. She shall not play at Cards, Dice, or any other unlawful Game, whereby her said Master - may have Damage. With her own Goods, nor the Goods of others, without Licence from her said Master - she shall neither buy nor sell. She shall not absent herself Day nor Night from her said Masters - Service, without h~~is~~ Leave: Nor haunt Ale-houses, Taverns, or Play-houses; but in all Things behave herself as a faithful Apprentice ought to do, during the said Term. And the said Master - shall use the utmost of his Endeavour to teach or cause to be taught or instructed the said Apprentice, in the Trade or Mystery of

and procure and provide for her sufficient Meat, Drink, *Apparel* Lodging and Washing, fitting for an Apprentice, during the said Term of *Seventeen years & three Months* and shall and will

in the course of the said term send the said Apprentice one year & six Months to School in the day time that is to say three Months thereof within the four last years of the said term and at the expiration thereof shall & will give unto her one good new suit of Apparel & besides her common every day Cloathing

AND for the true Performance of all and singular the Covenants and Agreements, aforesaid, the said Parties bind themselves each unto the other, firmly by these Presents. IN WITNESS whereof, the said Parties have interchangeably set their Hands and Seals hereunto. Dated the *twenty sixth* Day of *April* Annoque Domini, One Thousand Eight Hundred and *five*.
