I worked as the Civic Engagements Intern for Centre College in efforts to prepare for the upcoming

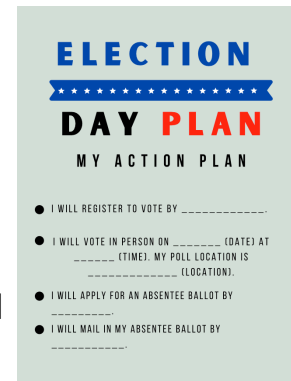
presidential election and promote a civically engaged campus.
