Telephone Line – Historical Inquiry Facilitator/Teacher Guide

- 1. Split up groups of learners into two groups
- 2. Have them move to two sides of the room
- 3. Get them to form a circle or line
- 4. Have two learners at the beginning of the line come to you to receive phrases
- 5. The phrases can be anything, the facilitator/teacher can choose whichever phrase they would like (do not make it to long or too short)
- 6. Instruct students to whisper the phrase to the next person in line and move down the line in synchronous order
- 7. Can only say the phrase once
- 8. Once completed ask the last student in the line or circle to say what they heard, chances are it will not be the original phrase
- 9. Have learners move back to original seats and conduct deconstruction, please refer to PP presentation for suggested deconstruction points
