I will reintroduce myself to you, since it has been a long time we were last in touch with each other. I wrote you on September 9, 1936 and you replied by hand written letter on September 11. You sent me quite an amount of information on the 124th, which I found very interesting. To let you know a bit more about me personally, I was drafted and on March 3rd, 1941, I was the only draftee assigned to Company D and two others were assigned to other companies. We were the first ones from Selective Service and in later weeks were followed by enough men to, I think, bring the Regiment up to full strength. I was later, about a month later, transferred to Service Company, and was on Special Duty with Headquarters Company as Stenographer to Capt T.A. Hancock, Regimental Adjutant.

I am enclosing a picture for your archives. Please return it to me when it has served its purpose. It is my only copy, and my family's favorite uniform picture. It was taken in the fall of 1941 while I was on maneuvers in Carolina where I was stenographer to Col Baker, S-4, 17 Army Corps.

I am enclosing a reprint of "The Gator". I have the original copy. There are two coincidence about this: Note the date of publication is June 6, '41 this was exactly three years prior to the Invasion of France, from England under direction of Eisenhower. The man sitting behind the desk looks like a typical cartoon of "Ike" but it is not Ike-Ike came into prominence later that fall when he was assigned Chief of Staff for Krueger of the 3rd Army and was involved in the Louisiana maneuvers, and come into prominence along with Patton, Drum, Leer, McNair and others. These two coincidence are almost prophetic.

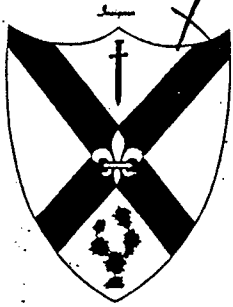
For your information and reference, if you can use them, I have the following original newspapers, and also invasion money, both French and German. The publications are as follows:

I am letting you know I have these, just in case you might find them useful in your publishing endeavor. I do not wish to give them away, but we can make copies, although they are quite fragile.

One thing I have been trying to determine with no success, is the fate of Company D, 124th Infantry. I understand they were detached from the 124th, and sent to the Pacific where they were ambushed and slaughtered. Please send me any information you may have on this. Someone told me
