(1) Each officer, warrant officer and flight officer is authorized not to exceed 25 pounds of baggage in addition to the weight of clothing, equipment and personal baggage authorized at the time of his original overseas movement. Containers for baggage of those individuals will be limited to:

- 1 trunk locker (duffel bag may be substituted at the option of the individual concerned)
- 1 bedding roll (not over 50 pounds)
- 1 piece of hand baggage, or for personnel on flying status, 1 B-4, bag (not over 40 lbs).
- 1 Field or musette bag
- 1 bag, flyers, medium, type A-3, for flying equipment (for personnel on flying status traveling by water)

(2) General Officers will be allowed one additional trunk locker or wardrobe trunk.

(3) Officers will have only one piece of hand baggage or B-4 bag and the Field or musette bag in their staterooms. As a general rule, bedding rolls and trunk lockers will not be available during the voyage. In addition to the items authorized above, Chaplains will be permitted to carry with them in their staterooms a Mass Kit or a Communion Set.

(4) In addition to clothing and equipment authorized in this order, each enlisted individual will be authorized, not to exceed 25 pounds of baggage for personal items and captured materiel trophies. Baggage of enlisted personnel will be limited to personal equipment and 1 duffel bag, or, for personnel on flying status, 1 B-4 bag. The duffel bag or B-4 bag

as required, packaged, crated or boxed, properly tagged, segregated on basis of serviceability (i.e. serviceable, repairable or non-repairable), and will have had first and second echelon maintenance service performed thereon in so far as the using organization is capable of performing.

6. Effective upon departure from present overseas station, Shipment RK-602 will be released from assignment to Commanding General, AFWESPAC and placed under the control of the Commanding General, Army Service Forces until released to proper authority in the United States.



2. The 31st Division and attached units will move with a total aggregate strength not in excess of 19,310 personnel.

3. a. This movement involves a permanent change of station.

b. Shipment RK-602. will move on or about 31 October 1945 from present overseas station to a United States port at which, units will be demobilized in accordance with orders to be issued by the War Department.

4. The Commanding General, 31st Infantry Division will insure that:

(3) Expendables, based upon a maximum of two pounds per individual, including such items as blank forms, envelopes, pencils and cleaning and preserving materials, will accompany each unit.

(4) Individual arms: Only such individual arms necessary for possible guard duties while aboard a transport will accompany units returning to the United States for demobilization. Ammunition allowance is one (1) clip for each weapon necessary.

c. All individuals will pack or carry their belongings so that items considered necessary during the voyage will be readily accessible.

(1) Each officer, warrant officer and flight officer is authorized not to exceed 25 pounds of baggage in addition to the weight of clothing, equipment and personnel baggage authorized at the time of his original overseas movement.

The duffel bag or B-4 bag must travel with the unit, preferably in the hands of the owner. A barracks bag, if authorized for movement, will be carried in the duffel bag enroute. Personnel on flying status are authorized (in addition to the above) 1 bag, flying kit, type A-3, not to exceed the weight authorized in this order.

d. Each individual is authorized not more than 7 pounds of personal hand items of recreational equipment to be carried on his person or in his pack. (See WD Cir 334, 1944 for authorization for shipment of additional hand recreational equipment, including radios).

e. Recreational equipment, radios and one 16 mm Motion Picture Projector for each battalion or similar unit of 880 or more men, procured by units from appropriated or non-appropriated funds, and individually owned recreational equipment, including radios, may accompany any unit as organizational impediments. One film is authorized for each projector. The total recreational equipment, including radios, authorized to be shipped as organizational impediments will not exceed the aggregate of 5 pounds per individual or 50 pounds per unit, whichever is greater. Bulky equipment (pool tables, furniture, pianos, etc.) will not accompany a unit.

f. Organizational trophies may be retained by units to be shipped to the United States as organizational impediments.

g. Flags, colors, standards and guidons will be returned to the United States with the units.
