

**As to the Division of the Territory,**

The division of the Territory is occupying the attention of the Legislature. The members from the extreme eastern and northeastern counties are strongly in favor of the division, and I have no doubt Congress will be memorialized on the subject, and in due time the new Territory of Idaho will be organized. The members from Walla-Walla county are strongly opposed to the division, for the reason, as they say, that the town of Walla-Walla is the geographical centre of the Territory as it now is, and they insist that the capital shall be removed from Olympia to that city.

A new county will be organized, to be called Boise county, containing the extensive region in which the new gold discoveries were recently made called the Boise mines. No legislation of importance will be perfected until after the holidays.
