The report in relation to the death of Gen. Lane has proved incorrect. He is lying at Roseburg, and is said to

be slowly recovering.

The steamer Col. Wright is again in motion, making her regular trips between the Des Chutes and Walla Walla. The Okinagan has been placed between Walla Walla and Slaterville, on the Clearwater. There is an immense travel between these points. I am informed that the Col. Wright's passenger and freight bill, on the trip on which she met with the accident, amounted to \$10,000.

The election of Wallace as Delegate to Congress from Washington is looked upon as a fixed fact, by all parties here. After the manner in which Garfielde received his nomination, he receives but little sympathy here, even among
