

WITHDRAWAL OF THE TROOPS.—Recent orders from the East require the immediate withdrawal of all the United States troops on this coast to New York. From the *Portland Daily Advertiser* we learn that the force in the military department of the Pacific amounts to some twenty-five hundred rank and file, comprising the 4th, 6th and 9th regiments of Infantry, eight companies of the 1st Cavalry, and six companies of the 3d Artillery. It is said that the troops in this district are to be relieved by volunteers from California.
