An Act.

To furnish Persons, who sell intoxicating Liquors, ammunition & firearms to minors.

§ 1. If any person who deals in intoxicating Liquors, whole sale or retail, or who deals in ammunition or firearms, shall sell or give away to minors, without the written consent of their parents, guardians or legal representatives, any intoxicating Liquors, ammunition or firearms, he or she shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before any District Court, Justice of the peace, or Mayor of any city or incorporated town, shall be fined in any sum not less than fifty nor more than five hundred Dollars.
