THE new Adelaide Exchange has now been brought into communication with Port Adelaide by a regular telephonic system. A room has been fitted up with telephones, under the direction of Mr. Todd, which connect with the Port Adelaide Telegraph Office, and persons can converse with each other at the two ends with perfect privacy. The facilities thus afforded are likely to prove of great public benefit, and should the experiment prove successful, it will pave the way to a much more extended system of telephonic intercommunication.
