Synopsis: Lobby for new telegraph line to Lancelot

Summary: Train passengers delayed by changed arrangements for postal sorting at Terowie

On Monday evening a public meeting was held at the institute. It was convened "to memorialize the Government to construct a line through Lancelot to join the Silverton line, and other matters of local interest." <clip>

<clip> Mr. E. P. Brady said there was another matter which he wished to bring before the meeting. Through a freak of the Government or Mr. Todd's the sorting of the North-East mails was now done at Petersburg instead of Terowie. Passengers were delayed here transferring and at Petersburg on account of the mails and the time at either place was too short to allow refreshments to be taken comfortably. He thought the mails should be sorted here as previously.
