Dr. Jim Cameron responded, "propinquity." It was 1960; World History class. The male ENC student's question was, "What is important in determining whom you marry?" -- (ENC professors were often asked questions somewhat unrelated to the subject...) Some of you soon became examples, in fortifying Dr. Cameron's point (remember he was also a champion debater):

And God blessed your unions, and your families, and your ministry. Some of you literally followed each other to the ends of the earth in your missionary labors together -- Africa, China, New Guinea -- and beyond.

George and Betty Porter pastored and George worked for the State of PA for approx, 32 years. They still live in Harrisburg, PA.; On 89th Street.

We were married June 4, 1960. Betty and George were married in 1961.

Don Brotherton, Unknown location. He origionally came from Ohio.

Esther (Fetter) Jozfik came from Kylertown, PA, Merle's sister.

Barbara and Merle both were committed to Boston Chapel and it's success.

James Fischmann married Pat Heckert and pastored Nazarene Churches and they now live in Claremont, New Hampshire.

Jack Shankel pastored Nazarene Churches and is now retired after being the District Supt. on the Maine District. He married a PA. girl. Christina Fetter is Merle's niece and lives in State College, PA.
