Please find attached the corrected color-keyed map of the Boston Chapel area identifying the setting as it was during the 1950s. (The color key for the four important surrounding sites was missing from the map prematurely sent forward for the Boston Chapel Archives by e-mail on January 29th).

Red, Green, Yellow and Blue colors on the map identify sites of the Chapel, the South End organized mob headquarters on Tremont Street, the Village Street curbside parking place of the Chapel's 2 buses and carry-all wagon, and the nearest Police Station. It should be noted that the stashed money at 617 Tremont Street from the 1950 "Crime of the Century" Brinks robbery (this money was discovered there by the FBI in June 1956) and Boston Police Station #4, located behind 502 Tremont Street, were within a 5 minute walk of the Chapel...
