Just got back home , after almost 3 busy weeks of "hanging drywall " at my daughters in MO.---am "recovering" ! You may(or may not) have the 53,54and 55 copies of the Nautilus available---All of the these mention the Boston chapel program---I can copy the pages about the chapel and send them "snail mail" along with other information re: the beginning days. I was mistaken -- when I told you I served as EA Presiden t the year the work began (1953) I was however one of the group leaders and actively involved in the beginning stages of exploring the possibility of opening the Ministry. I served as EA president in 1954 and the Chapel was a primary focus that year . I remember on one of the early trips to "check out" the site there was a Gypsy woman sitting cross-legged in the window...beckoning us to come in...apparently to read our fortunes...
