

Rev. Gerald "Jerry" E. Huff, 84, Joplin, Mo., formerly of Carthage, Mo., passed away Tuesday, Sept. 13, 2011, at Spring River Christian Village, Joplin.

Gerald Ellis Huff was born Aug. 24, 1927, in Kearney, N.J., the son of Edward E. Huff and Marion E. (Green) Huff. He received his bachelors degree from Eastern Nazarene College, Quincy, Mass. and his masters degree from Mankato State University, Mankato, Minn.

He married Peggy L. DeVall on Dec. 5, 1945, in Elizabeth City, N.C.; she survives.

Mr. Huff was a U.S. Navy veteran during World War II serving aboard several U.S. Navy ships. He was a high school English teacher and a prison chaplain in New York state.
