The Daisy O. K. Mill is a counterpart of our celebrated O. K. Mill, except the four corner posts of the tower are extended above the platform and run up close to the main casting, and with the long pipe mast cut off and made to

pivot above the platform.

K. has proved itself to be, but the change was made simply to please some of our agents who would have no other mill but the O. K., and yet wanted a mill with the tower posts extending up to the main casting.
