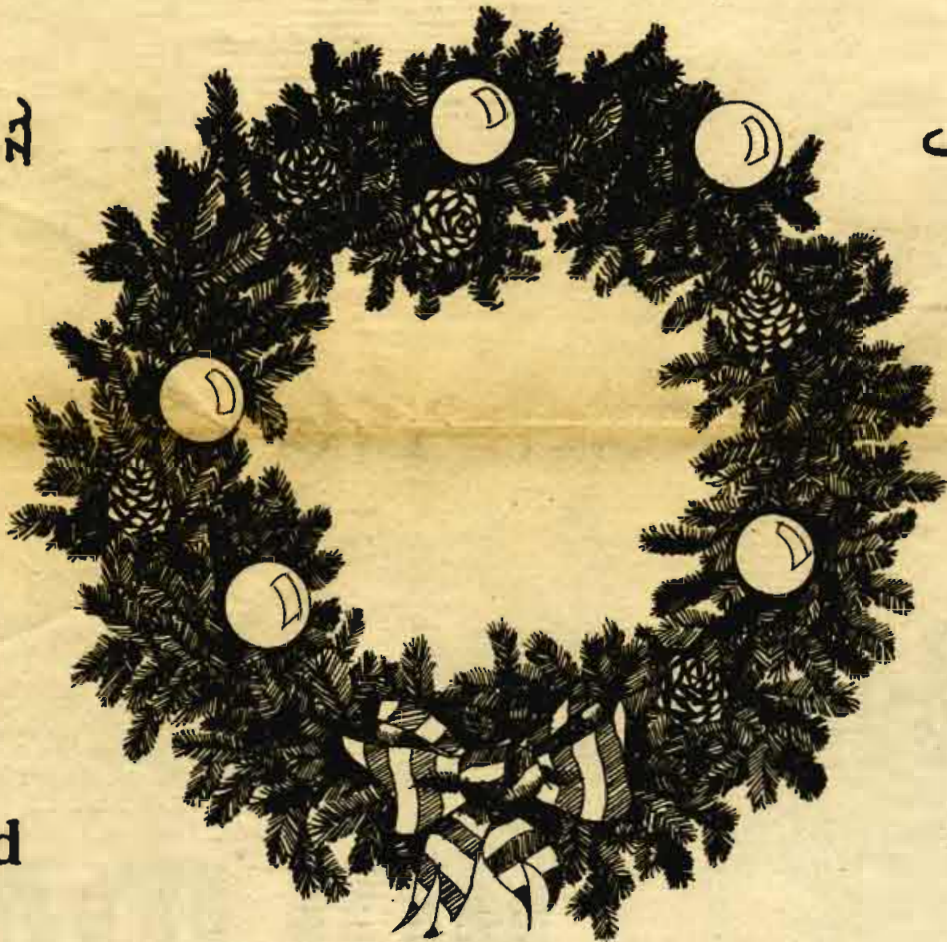

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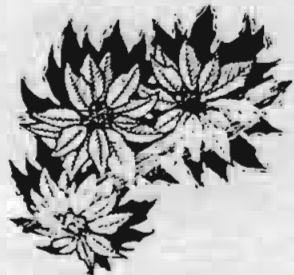

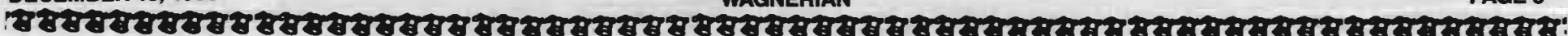

Probably this letter will never see print, but your article "Freshman Enrollment Goes Down" deserves a reply and some insight as to the "Why's."

Turn to the Administration for your answers. While at Wagner I had come to know and love the student body and I am concerned.

The drop in enrollment has little to do with the tuition increase or the elevation of academic standards, nor the dismissal of border line cumulative averages, nor the rejection of new students by admissions.

More in line with the truth is the college's lack of a Christian attitude toward their student body. Possibly students should ask more questions about the administrative operations. Questions such as:

Who is there at Wagner were a student can turn to for help and assistance when faced with a financial problem? Do you have a President or Vice-President who will invite such a conference? .

Who is there to help a student who needs a helping hand, be it words of encouragement, be it someone to contact a government agency or bank to resolve a financial aid problem?

Who is there who will spend a few minutes on a telephone with a parent needing some guidance and to relieve their anxieties?

Who is there that can honestly admit that they have created an atmosphere of congeniality and developed a good rapport with students and parents?

Unfortunately, I predicted this enrollment drop the day I left Wagner. I am also certain that enrollment will increase if the Administration develops a more Christian attitude if the above questions are resolved. A good and honest administrative rapport with students is seriously lacking at Wagner. This attitude must be reversed for Wagner to move ahead into the 21st. century.

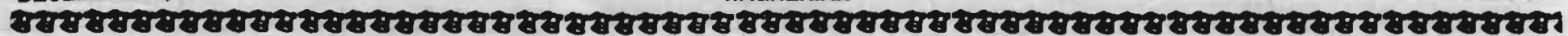

Book Review

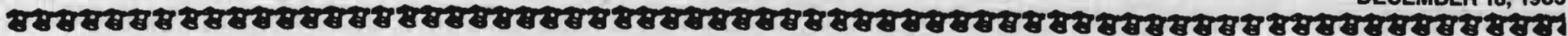
NURSE

A Berkley Book 1978

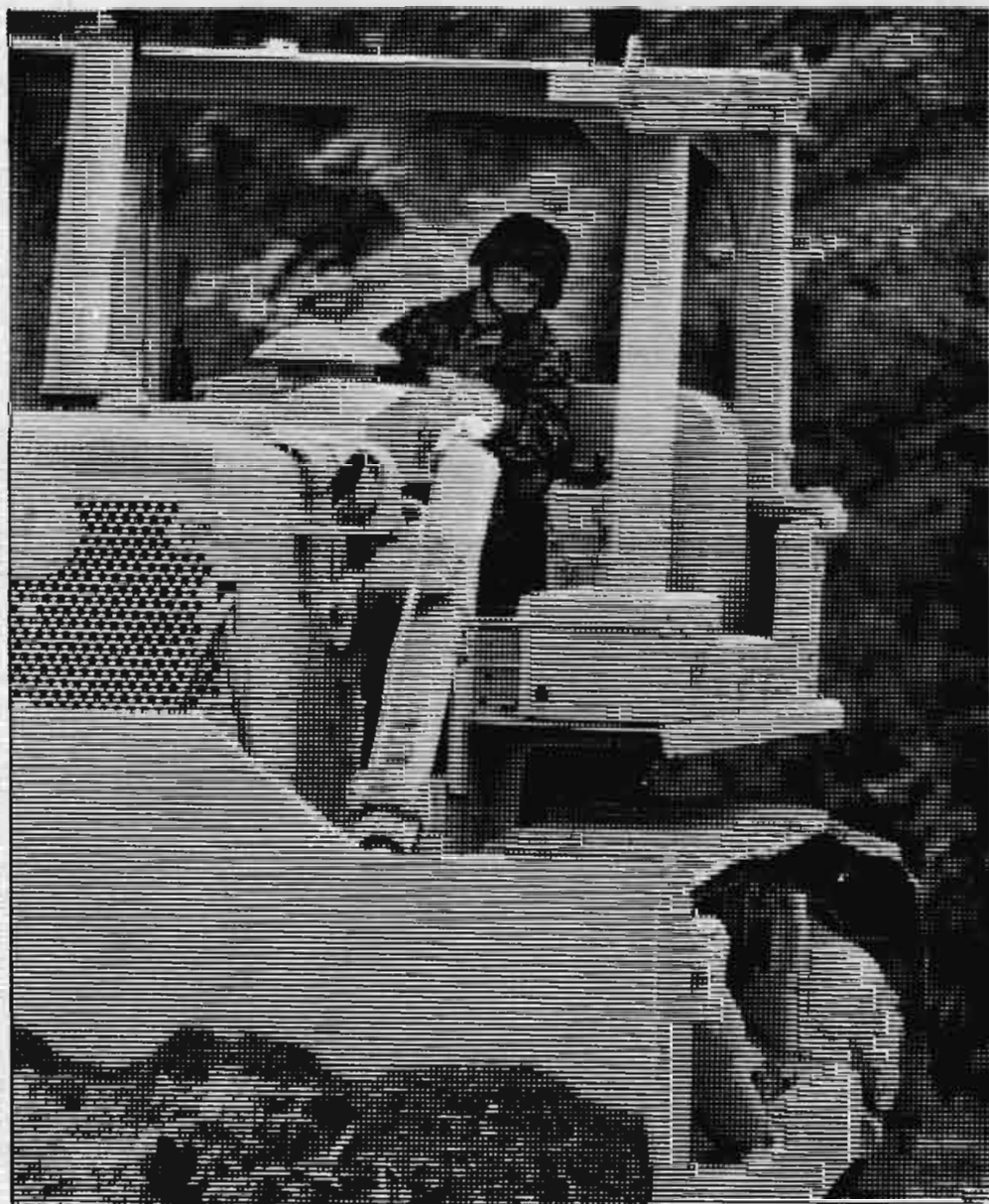

The "I" belongs to the young woman whose experiences comprise this book. She is head nurse on a general medical-surgical floor of a metropolitan hospital in a large American city. She is 27 years old. At her request, the author has changed her name. The identity of the hospital itself and of all the other characters of whom are doctors, nurses, and other hospital personnel. Likewise, the patients and their families and the husband, family, and friends of this nurse have been changed, and certain situations disguised, to preserve the privacy of the people involved. The writer of this book took some liberties with chronology, but the stuff is true. Every experience recorded has happened in real life to this nurse. I think this would be an excellent book to recommend to the women studying to be nurses at Wagner.
