Goldsmith Residence



This is an old and new picture of Alban Goldsmith's house. Alban Goldsmith trained in medicine and surgery under E. McDowell, lived in the house from 1825-1830, and was a medical forerunner (3rd ovariotomy in US - 1823 & 1st laminectomy in US -1829).

In urban renewal funding, \$148,000 was set aside for the restoration of Goldsmith House, Grayson Tavern, and the Fisher Row house complex.

The Goldsmith House is now the visitors center for the Danville-Boyle County Convention and Visitors Bureau (CVB) in 2019. They have guided tours of Constitution Square and historic downtown.
