LOULIE GREENFIELD VICTOR (1874-1952)

Loulie Greenfield VICTOR, daughter of Henry Clay VICTOR and Rebecca Jane Tilden MacLEOD, was born 9 September 1874, in Lynchburg, Virginia. [Burial record, Diuguid Funeral Home, Lynchburg, VA, Book 42, p. 116; Obituary, *Lynchburg News*, 16 December 1952, Sect. II, p. 3 col. 2.]

On 4 October 1898, Loulie G. VICTOR married James Richeson MILLNER, founder of MILLNER's Department Store in Lynchburg. [Marriage Register, Lynchburg, VA, Book 4, p. 36; *Lynchburg News*, 5 October 1898, p. 8 col. 4; Obituary, loc.cit.]

Loulie G. (VICTOR) MILLNER was a charter member of the Memorial Methodist Church and was a former president of the Women's Society of Christian Service. She was also a member of the Blue Ridge Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution. She died 15 December 1952 in Lynchburg, Virginia. [Obituary, loc.cit.]
