**THE MOLLIE CLARKSON (1848-aft.1911) SCRAPBOOK**

The scrapbook includes mostly newspaper clippings and pictures collected by Miss CLARKSON. The scrapbook also includes notes written to her by friends at Hollins Institute, Roanoke County, Virginia.

**MARY ("MOLLIE") CLARKSON (1848-aft.1911)**

Mary CLARKSON, the daughter of John Nicholas CLARKSON and Anne L. EARLY, was born 30 May 1848, in Charleston, West Virginia. She was educated at St. Mary's College in Raleigh, North Carolina, and at a finishing school in Richmond, Virginia. She married 29 September 1872, in Charleston, Augustus L. LANGLEY, son of William H. LANGLEY and Caroline MILLER. A member of the United Daughters of the Confederacy, Mary ("Mollie") (CLARKSON) LANGLEY died after 1911, perhaps in Charleston, West Virginia.
