JOHN BARBEE MINOR (1813-1895)

John Barbee MINOR, son of Lancelot MINOR and Mary O. TOMPKINS, was born 2 June 1813 in Louisa County, Virginia. He was admitted to the Albemarle (County) bar in 1830. [John B. Minor, *The Minor Family of Virginia* (Lynchburg, VA: J. P. Bell, 1923), pp. 22, 52.] He graduated from the University of Virginia in 1834 and practiced law in Botetourt County for several years. He later joined his brother, Lucian, in a law practice in Charlottesville, Virginia.
