CATHERINE ESTELLE BISHOP SHAW (1912-2002)

Catherine Estelle Bishop, daughter of Milton Lafayette and Jessie May Bishop, was born September 20, 1912, in Roanoke, Virginia. She married Earl Wilbur Shaw (1915-1991) on December 6, 1941. They were the parents of three children.

Mrs. Shaw was a registered nurse for forty years. She was also a genealogist and was author of *Ancestors are Like Four Leaf Clovers – Seek and Ye Shall Find*, published in 1995. She was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, the Daughters of American Colonists, the Jamestowne Society, the Court of Honor, and the Virginia Poet Society.

Mrs. Shaw died April 19, 2002, at her home in Lynch Station, Virginia. She was buried in the Mount Hermon United Methodist Church cemetery in Lynch Station.
