FRANK CONRAD WEILAND III (1940-2022)

Frank Conrad Weiland III, son of Frank C. Weiland, Jr., and Ruby Carwile Weiland, was born February 19, 1940, in Lynchburg, Virginia. He married Betty Burnett Weiland (1944-2007) in 1963. He was in the U.S. Navy and was a member of the Tin Can Sailors, a group of Naval veterans who served on destroyer warships. Frank worked at the Lynchburg Foundry until retirement and later worked at Jefferson Lighting in Lynchburg. Frank died January 31, 2022, and is buried in the Womack Family cemetery in Prince Edward County, Virginia.
