His Indenture made this 6th Day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one between William Harris of Campbell County of the one part and James McHorney of the same County of the other part, Witnesseth that he the said William Harris for and in consideration of the full sum of Thirty pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid (the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge) hath granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien, deliver and confirm unto him the said James McHorney his Heirs and Assigns forever, one certain tract or parcell of Land containing 200 Acres (or the same more or less) the same being part of a tract granted to the said William Harris by Patent for nine hundred and forty Acres) Situate in Campbell County on West branches of Cheese Creek
