ELEANOR HARRIS MACRAE (1916-2010)

Eleanor Harris MacRae was born 12 April 1916 in Prince Edward County, the daughter of Marshall Diuguid Harris and Mary Elam Harris. She graduated from Prospect High School and Farmville State Teachers College, now Longwood University. She was the wife of Neill MacRae, Jr., from Littleton, North Carolina, for 65 years. She was the proud mother of four sons: Howard I. Smith, of Richmond; Cary Marshall Smith, of Roanoke; Neill MacRae III, of Roanoke; and Roderick MacRae, of Lynchburg.

Upon her husband's retirement in 1969, the family moved from Roanoke to Virginia Beach where they enjoyed their second career in real estate. Mrs. MacRae was a member of The Huguenot Society, National Society Daughters of the American Revolution, the United States Daughters of 1812, and the Colonial Dames of the XVII Century. In her later years, she enjoyed the hobby of genealogy and was the author of three books on the subject for which she was given national recognition by the families involved in her research.

Mrs. MacRae was a member of the Bethpeor Baptist Church in Prince Edward County during her youth. She was also a member of the First Baptist Church of Richmond and Cave Spring United Methodist Church of Roanoke. She had recently transferred her membership back to Bethpeor Baptist Church.

Eleanor Harris MacRae died 17 March 2010 in Virginia Beach, Virginia, and was buried in the Harris family plot at the Bethpeor Baptist Church in Prince Edward County.
