VILLAGE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH SESSIONAL RECORDS

The sessional records of this church include minutes of both the session meetings and congregational meetings of Village Presbyterian Church, Charlotte County, for the period 12 November 1825 to 11 April 1859. Also included in the records are membership lists 1826-1858, recording some death dates to 1891, baptismal records 1826-1857, and dismissals 1828-1845. The Village Presbyterian Church was first organized in 1825 for the members of the Cub Creek Church who lived near Charlotte Court House.
