MARY SAMPSON DIUGUID (1883-1968)

Mary Sampson DIUGUID, daughter of William D. DIUGUID and Nora COTRELL, was born 29 May 1883, in Lynchburg, Virginia. She graduated from Randolph-Macon Woman's College and studied art with Louise Jordan SMITH. She attended art schools in Philadelphia, in New York, in Spain and in Portugal. She also studied with George ENNIS of Florida and with Pierre DAURA and Henry B. SNELL of Lynchburg. In addition to being an artist of some note, Miss DIUGUID was president of W. D. Diuguid, Inc., "one of the oldest mortuaries in the state," from 1927 to 1946. Miss DIUGUID was a member of the Lynchburg Art Club, the Lynchburg Fine Arts Center, and the Woman's Club. She died 25 August 1968 and was buried in the Sherwood Burial Park in Salem, Virginia.
