**WINFREE SONS AND MAUPIN**

According to city directories, WINFREE Sons and MAUPIN manufactured plug tobacco in Lynchburg, Virginia, from ca. 1885 until ca. 1891. The partnership included John B. WINFREE, Jr. (1870-1942), Robert WINFREE (1865-1928), Christopher WINFREE, Jr. (1864-1891), all sons of John Bell Tilden WINFREE and Ann Elizabeth PENNINGTON. The partnership also included Addison MAUPIN. Nothing further is known of the partnership at present. It may have been discontinued after the death of Christopher WINFREE, Jr., in 1891.
