The collection includes mimeographed letters and charts from the Committee for Open Administration to the City Council of Lynchburg, Va. The committee requested tax relief for the newly-annexed areas of Campbell County and Bedford County and presented its concerns regarding proposed reassessments, utilities and other city services to be provided, as well as fair representation on the Council. The committee was formerly known as the Citizens' Committee to Oppose Annexation. The chairman of the original committee, George A. Orlicki, offered himself as a candidate for councilman-at-large in 1976.
