Henrietta Apperson Barker was born 15 May 1919 in Lynchburg, Virginia, the daughter of William Carey Barker and Margaret Miller Apperson. She was educated at E.C. Glass High School. She traveled with older sister, Margaret Apperson Barker to Europe in 1932-1933. She married John Holmes Kyle. During World War II, she was a member of American Red Cross Club Mobile overseas.

Henrietta Barker Kyle died 26 November 1978, and was buried in Spring Hill Cemetery, Lynchburg.
