Lone Jack Tobacco





In 1859, John W. Carroll began producing his Lone Jack smoking tobacco from a small, frame factory on 12th Street between Madison and Harrison streets. It didn't take long for Lone Jack to become the mos renowned of Lynchburg's tobacco brand and for Carroll to become one of the mos wealthy, well-known, and influential people in Lynchburg.

A publication written at the turn of the century describes the high quality of Lond Jack as "entirely free from any mixture adulteration or flavoring whatever. The pure granulated leaf of the best and sweetes tobacco grown, free from stems, uniform throughout in color, fineness, strength and flavor, affording to all true lovers of the weed a delicious, satisfying and enjoyable smoke."

As this acclaimed tobacco grew in popularity, Carroll built a new factory on Grack Street between 12th and 13th streets, known as Lone Jack No. 1. In 1900 a supply of about one-quarter million pounds of tobacco was kept on hand to support their booming industry.

Despite three decades of prosperity, the popularity of Lone Jack Tobacco began to wane, and by the early part of the twentieth century the product was no longer bein produced in Lynchburg.



GREY GABLES

Located on the north side of the South Anna River on Byrd Mill Road (Route 649) near the waters i Chamberlayne Creek, Grey Gables stands on a portion of a vast land patent of John Ragland of Hanover County. In 1770, his son, Samuel, sold 115 acres of this land to Thomas Wash, who died in 1780. In his will Thomas asked that this land be divided equally among his three sons, one of whom, Thomas, Jr., sold his 238-acre share in 1783 William Harris.

In 1792 William and Henrietta Harris of fluvanna County sold the property to Thomas Barnett, who conveyed it in 1806 to Claibourn Walton. It was probably during the Walton whership that the present house was built, as there appears to have been a house on the property when labourn and Milley Warren Walton sold it to hhn Carroll in 1818.

for over forty years Grey Gables belonged to John

and his wife, Mary Perkins Carroll, and it is as their home that the house is best known. In 1861, prior to John's death, he deeded the property to his sonin-law, Joseph C. Talley. Joseph resided there until his death, and in 1892 the Talley heirs sold the home to Miletus T. and Mary S. Gooch, who were living there at that time. In 1902 M. J. Wiltshire purchased the home, and since then it has changed hands many times, being owned in turn by the Sutlers, E. A. Estes, Blanche Phillips Puller and Victoria Fletcher, the Roaches, the Cranks, the Rosses, the Murrays, the Albrights, the Yoders, and Douglas H. Dabney, the present owner.

Grey Gables is a two-story frame dwelling constructed over a brick foundation. It has inside brick end chimneys and a large four-columned front portico. There is a Carroll family cemetery located on the property.

The Carroll Family (Notes from Zeb Ragland)

Among the first Carrolls in America is the name of Charles Carroll of Maryland, a signer of the Declaration of Independence.

The name "Carriell" is found on rent books of Northampton County, Va., in 1704. "Carriell" is also found at Jamestown, Va. This may be an old spelling of Carroll.

The first concrete evidence we have is that Sarah Carroll of Carroll's Creek, in Albemarle County, near Fber, Va., married John Dawson in 1757. She may have been an aunt of George Washington Carroll.

John Carroll, b. 1-22-1784 Orange County, d. 5-26-1861 at his home, Grey Gables in Louisa County, m. 3-17-1815 Louisa County to Mary (Polly) Perkins, b. 2-27-1796 and d. 9-16-1857 Louisa County.

Their son, George Washington Carroll, born ca 1821-22, d. 8-26-1886. (or April 26?), m. Mildred Ann Woody, b. ca 1825, d. 2-27-1864. Mildred Ann Woody Carroll is buried near Variety Mills, Va., in Nelson County.

A marriage license was issued to George Washington Carroll and Mildred Ann Woody on Sept. 22, 1845, at Nelson County Courthouse. The security was John Carroll, his father. The minister was Joel Fortune.

George Washington Carroll was from the Carroll's Creek area and his wife was from the Variety Mills area, near Arrington, VA.

George W. Carroll and Mildred Ann Woody Carroll had five children: Paul Acie Carroll; **Willie Anna Carroll; Richard Baxter Carroll; George Andrew Carroll; and Mary Elizabeth Carroll.

from the book: "Famous Signers of the Declaration of Independence" by Dorothy Hunter McGee:

Charles Carroll of Carrollton (9-19-1737-1832 descended from Irish kings. His grandfather, Charles Carroll, emigrated to Baltimore in 1688. His son was Charles Carroll of Annapolis, born in Annapolis, and married Elizabeth Brooke. This Charles Carroll was the first Senator from Maryland and the last surviving signer of the Declaration of Independence.

The home of the Carrolls near Ellicott City, MD was called Doughoregan Manor.

The first Charles Carroll, "the settler", came from Ireland in 1688 as an agent for Lord Baltimore. His son, Charles Carroll of Annapolis, called "Breakneck" Carroll, was killed in a fall from steps on his property.

The third Charles Carroll, the last signer of the Declaration of Independence, was the only son of the second Charles Carroll ("Breakneck"). The cousin of this Charles Carroll was John Carroll who became the first Archbishop of Baltimore, died 1832 and is buried at Doughoregan Manor, burial place of many Carrolls.

Doughoregan Manor was owned in 1917 by Charles Bancroft Carroll (8th of the Charles Carrolls) and grandson of John Lee Carroll, a former Governor of Maryland.

Charles Carroll of Homewood, son of the "signer", lived at Homewood Estate near Baltimore city limits, on Charles St. Blvd.
