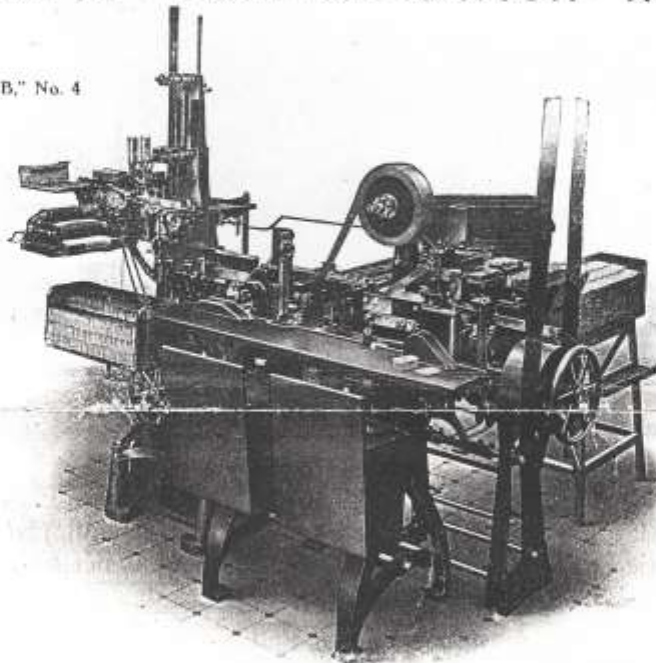

Feeding material (printed labels), making the cup (U.S.A. style, open at top, with rounded edges), wrapping the cigarettes in foil (parchment paper lined), inserting same into the cup, with or without picture (10 or 20 cigarettes in three rows), folding and gumming foil at top (well stuck), and delivering the packages upon a receiving table completely finished.

Net Output: 10's, 400,000 cigarettes per day; 20's, 700,000 cigarettes per day.

Attendance: 3 young persons.
Power: 1/3 H.P.

Floor space: 6-ft. x 5-ft.
Approximate net weight: 13 cwts.
