

Locust pointers, thence South seventy three degrees West
 fifty one poles to pointers, thence South fifty three degrees West
 seventy two poles to post oak, thence South seventy seven and
 half degrees West seventy six poles to pointers, thence South
 Sixty four degrees East seventy six poles to black oak, -
 thence South Eight degrees West Sixty seven poles to white
 oak, thence North Eighty Eight degrees East one Hundred
 and sixty six poles to corner tree (not named) thence
 South forty five degrees East one Hundred and Ninety two
 poles Van on blackwater creek, thence North seventy five
 degrees East thirty four poles to red oak, thence South
 forty five degrees East six poles to the creek, thence down
 the creek as it meanders opposite to the mouth of the
 meeting house branch on the south side of said creek crossing
 said creek up the said branch as it meanders to white oak on
 the East side of said branch thence South fourteen degrees
 East nine poles to white oak, thence North fifty one degrees East
 one Hundred and one poles to pointers, thence South seventy
 seven degrees East one Hundred sixty seven poles to red oak,
 on Dry left, thence North seven Degrees West fourteen
 poles to the creek, thence up the said creek as it meanders
 opposite to the mouth of Harolds branch on the South side
 of said creek crossing said creek to mouth of said branch
 thence South thirty six and half degrees West fifty four
 poles to red oak, thence South sixty six and half degrees
 West thirty two and half poles to post oak, thence
 South thirty seven and half degrees West one Hundred
 and thirty two poles to red oak, thence South thirty
 seven ^{and one half} degrees East one Hundred and eighty eight poles
 to sugar tree on the river, thence up the said river as it
 meanders two Hundred and nine poles to the first
 station, Mulberry tree. To have and to hold the
 said tract or parcel of Land, and its appurtenances
 to the said James Steptoe, Caleb Hale, and Jas. Callaway Jr
 and their heirs forever as Tenants in common and to
 their
